The way into a talk - a game, quiz, question, scenario or challenge that illustrates the meaning of the passage.

#### TEACH

What happens in the passage and what it means.

#### **APPLY**

What should our response be?

	ACCESS Once you're sure of the key meaning then plan something that illustrates the same idea in their world.	<ul> <li>TEACH</li> <li>What happens?</li> <li>Visual aid ideas?</li> <li>What does it teach us about God, Jesus, the Holy Spirit, us, the world, the church etc?</li> </ul>	<ul> <li>APPLY</li> <li>One or two simple (and Biblical) applications for us, now.</li> <li>Would this be best explored in small groups?</li> </ul>
